



How to... Bid Online in a Livestream Auction




Step 1



Click 'Bid for this property' on your chosen property at pattinson.co.uk/auction



Step 3




Click **'Verify Identity.'**

Please Note: You must first be registered & have verified your identity with your passport or drivers licence to be able to bid successfully online.



Step 5




Once you have submitted the registration form please click **'Verify my account.'** This will send us an alert to authorise your account for online bidding.

Please Note: This can take up to 24 hours so please register as soon as possible, to avoid missing out.





Step 7


